Online entries close at **11 p.m. on 17th February**. Venue: Aorangi Stadium, Timaru

There have been some changes to the programme this year and some events may have changed the day they are on. We have also changed some start times.

Please read the programme before entering.

Please note that ALL entries are being taken ONLINE this season.

Note: There are no refunds if you enter events then decide to withdraw.

Please remember that your name will appear in results as it is typed. i.e. if you type your name in lower case or CAPITALS it will come out in entry sheets and results in lower case or CAPITALS.

An itemised receipt will be e-mailed once payment is made. Please check that your events are correct. For seeding purposes in sprint events where heats might be required, your season's best performances are required.

Online entries along with credit card payment close at 11pm 17th February 2018.

Late Entries (including late entry fee of \$10) close 1 hour before the scheduled start time of an event.

Important note: For events run in lanes, late entries will only be accepted if there is an available lane. To avoid possible disappointment, make sure you pre-enter.

The final timed programme available Athletics Canterbury Website by Tuesday, 20th February.

Reporting In: All Athletes competing in track events up to & including 800m MUST report in at the TIC Room at least 30 minutes prior to the programmed event start time, so that accurate draws can be produced.

All field event athletes are required to report at least 15 minutes prior to the event start time.
